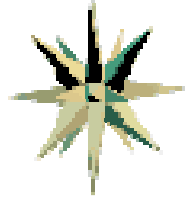

## From the Pastors Desk

### **Greetings to you, and, peace from God our Father, and our Lord, Jesus Christ!**

It seems pretty popular to wear a cross these days. I see crosses on people all over the place. I know that I should not judge someone by what I see at first impressions, but sometimes the cross and the individual's actions don't fit. I was recently reading an article about crosses and the writer actually heard one salesperson ask, "Do you want a plain cross or one with a little man on it?"

Before we wear a cross I believe that it is important that we consider the words of the Apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 1:18-31. "For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God . . . but we proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles,"

When we wear a cross it expresses that we believe in the power of God experienced through the love of Jesus Christ who gave his life on the cross. Jesus defeated death and sin and rose from the dead three days later. For those of us in the Protestant tradition wearing an empty cross also symbolizes the fact that the power of God defeated death and offers to us forgiveness and new life.

I hope that if you wear a cross that you will realize what you are saying when you put it on. "The cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it IS the power of God."
