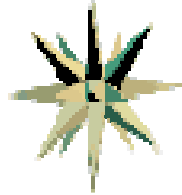

## From the Pastors Desk

### Who Is In Charge?

There is an interesting and sometimes perplexing story in 2 Samuel 6. King David had made Jerusalem his home city, everything was finally going well for him, and he decided to bring the ark of God to Jerusalem. Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab drove a new cart to bring the ark back. We read that the oxen shook the cart and Uzzah reached out to touch the ark and steady it. 2 Samuel 6:7 reads, "The anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God struck him there because he reached out his hand to the ark; and he died there beside the ark of God."

Why would God get angry at Uzzah for doing what appeared to be a very simple action of respect? Uzzah did not want the ark to fall on the ground. I have found that in stories like this one there is probably more involved than we are first able to see.

If we go a little deeper we find that Uzzah's action was probably not a mistake of the moment but grew out of a lifelong obsession to manage the ark and even God. There were clear guidelines about carrying the ark using poles inserted through rings. Uzzah ignored these guidelines and moved the ark via ox cart. He probably saw this as a much better and more efficient way of doing the moving than the guidelines laid down by God.

Do you ever get the feeling that you could handle things better than God? I think we sometimes forget that God enters our lives and changes them. A true faith results in transformation done by God. A true faith means we are open to the work of God in our lives.

I believe that when we tell others how to live their lives of faith, when we decide that we know the best and only ways to worship and serve God, when we determine God's will for our lives and the lives of others without truly listening to God we may just be running the same risk as Uzzah.

When we open our lives to God, changes happen. We are confronted by our sin, we are challenged to a new way of life, we are called to commitment, and we are forgiven and set free to mention just a few of the changes. Uzzah's death is a reminder however, that if we try to control God and put God in a box disaster will happen.

When you look at your life of faith ask yourself who is really in charge. It may be risky to truly let go and believe, but it certainly is exciting and even breath taking when God transforms our lives.

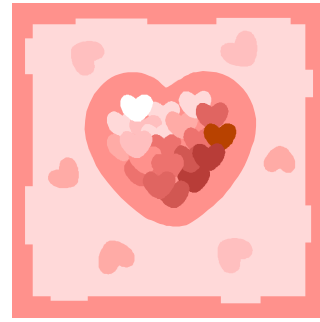
