From the Pastors Desk

August is not usually a month that the pastor talks about stewardship. Yet I believe that stewardship is actually something that we should think about all of the time not just in the Fall of the year. My hope is that you will begin to see your stewardship commitment not as an obligation or as something that gets put near the end of your priorities, but as a deep spiritual commitment which grows out of your relationship with Jesus Christ.

There is a primary principle that is essential to an understanding of stewardship as a part of our faith commitment. "Stewardship is a biblical concept that is also a matter of faith and response. The greater one knows of and has experienced the love of God, the greater will be the response as one offers to God his/her gifts of time, energy, talent, and financial resources to support ministries and bless lives."

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life." (John 3:16) Do you realize and know just how much you are loved by God? God's love is so deep that it has gone to this depth of personal sacrifice and giving. I'm not sure that we truly understand the depth of God's love for us and it is for this reason that our stewardship is often not a commitment, but a forced obligation. I'm afraid that we fail to see our stewardship as a wonderful opportunity to respond to God's love. Instead stewardship becomes a painful obligation that we resent if the church talks too much about money or asks for too much of our time.

Brothers and sisters God loves us more than we can ever fully comprehend. However as our faith deepens and we come to know and experience God's love in our lives our response will grow. When you are asked, by the church, to share your gifts of time, energy, talent, and financial resources to support the work and ministry here at Bethel United Church of Christ I challenge you to consider God's love for you. Ask how you will want to respond based upon how God loves you.
