“Our character is defined by what we do when we think no one is looking”

Dear Friends,

I recently read a short story about a woman who loves to build fences. According to this expert fence builder, “a fence says a lot about the person who built it. Was he in a hurry? Did she meticulously straighten each post and measure equidistantly between them? Build the fence to be standing in five years? Ten?” Obviously, the act of building a fence is something the writer takes to heart. In fact, she believes the work and time it takes to build a fence builds CHARACTER.

Webster's Dictionary defines character as “moral qualities distinctive to an individual.” If you're like me, I naturally assume that everyone has fine morals. But, every once in awhile, I discover that I was sadly naïve and made a poor judgment call about the character of a person.

Even when we think no one is looking and watching how we conduct ourselves, God is present. We can't hide from God. God, who knows every little hair on our head, knows what we think, what we say, and how we conduct ourselves. That alone should provide us with the impetus to live a life that children, siblings, co-workers, spouses, and friends want to exemplify. When we slip – which happens to all of us occasionally - we need to turn ourselves over to God and ask for help rebuilding our character and strength.

Since God is the ultimate judge of our character – and we're always under construction by God – I'm going to take you on a short journey this summer. Beginning July 30th, I'll be offering a four-part sermon series that focuses on building our character: how to control our thoughts, how to guard our hearts from those things that tear down character, what we should strive for in order to keep good company, and how the fruits of the spirit can help us to build our character.

Old Business:

- **Policies and Procedures:**
 - Prayer Chain: S. Tharp presented the policy to consistory for review. K. Weaver will work on the format.
 - F. Brillhart presented the revised Social Hall Agreement policy. E. Miller made a motion to accept the policy and L. McJunkin seconded the motion and all approved.

- Electronic Giving: K. Weaver presented additional information from PNC.
 - PNC cost is \$15 per month with a \$0.50 per transaction fee.
 - A discussion followed. F. Brillhart will check with the following banks; York Traditions, ACNB and People Bank.
- The financial policy that was distributed needs to be reviewed and consistory needs to be prepared to vote on the policy at the June's meeting.
- **Missions:**
 - **HACC:** (Pastor Sue) L. McJunkin, J. Ernst and F. Brillhart were our volunteers for April at HACC. All three acknowledged the great need at the center. Our volunteers were kept busy sorting clothes and folding clothes.
 - **Appalachian Mission:**
 - The Noisy Can offering totaled \$191.12 so far.
 - Sandwich sale: Bethel sandwich sales totaled \$772. All three churches sold \$2,118 with a net profit of \$950.
- **Building and Maintenance:**
 - **Consolidation of the mission boxes:** (T. Allison) Work in progress.
 - **Nursery:** The carpet was delivered. Thanks Lynn.
 - **Spring Cleaning** was successful. Thanks to everyone who participated.
 - **Youth Blue Bird Boxes:** We are beginning to see blue birds around the boxes.
 - Light bulbs in the office need to be replaced.
 - Hinge in the kitchen needs to be repaired.
 - One of the shelves under the pew is cracked.
- **Letters to former members:** We did not get any feedback from the people whom letters were mailed. Pastor Sue noted that the best way to bring people into the church is to invite them to a service.
- **Gettysburg Association Spring Meeting:** The meeting was held at Bethel on April 23rd with a social hour beginning at 2:30 PM and the meeting at 3 PM. Everyone who attended the meeting had a positive feedback.
- **Penn Central Conference Annual meeting:** The conference is scheduled for June 9th and 10th. Pastor Sue will attend both days. S. Tharp, J. Ernst and F. Brillhart will attend Saturday's session.
- **VBS:** Vacation Bible School is scheduled from Sunday June 26th to Thursday June 29th. The theme is Route 254 and has an RV camping theme. Pastor Sue distributed VBS information. Donated baskets will be raffled off to raise money for VBS and our Youth Class.
- **Mosaic Classes:** Larry Vickers is willing to offer the class again.
 - The schedule for the second class would be best offered in the fall/winter.
 - Larry would also like to present the mosaics that class made, and also offer a framing class.
- Signage for the outside of the church was ordered by T. Allison
- **Chicken BBQ Update:** The BBQ is scheduled for June 17th and the cost is \$8.00. The dinner includes ½ of a chicken, baked potato, apple sauce and a roll. Tickets for the BBQ will be available by the end of May. Volunteers are needed at the pavilion to distribute the dinners and at Jefferson carnival grounds to prepare the chicken.

New Business:

- An Eagle Scout project would include painting the social hall and other updates. It was also suggested the project include signage for the interior of the church. The scout needs to do a formal presentation to consistory.
- Internet Access: F. Brillhart contacted Century Link and he was given a monthly price for phone and internet of \$74.98 if payed by auto pay and \$79 if paid by invoice.
- Communication: Consistory discussed ways to communicate information to the congregation. A Meet the Press skit will be presented to inform the congregation.
- Consistory decided not to support the annual request for the Spring Grove Ambulance Club
- Pastor Sue requested vacations from 7/10 to 7/16 and 9/18 to 9/24. K. Weaver made a motion to accept the vacation time and L. McJunkin seconded and all approved.

- The possibility of a Youth Scholarship Fund was discussed. The scholarship would go to our youth attending higher education. The fund would be supported by donations and fundraisers. K. Weaver made a motion to accept the proposal and C. Worley seconded and all approved.
- Ascension Day Service was discussed. Consistory decided not to have this service because of the poor attendance.
- **Pentecost Communion Service:** (June 4th) Servers are C. Worley, S. Tharp, L. McJunkin and D. Bankert. Back-up server is F. Brillhart.
- **Social:**
 - The Fire Pit Activity is planned for Sunday June 11th at 5 PM. Please bring your favorite covered dish and enjoy roasting hotdogs by the fire and eating strawberries and ice-cream.
 - The church picnic will be on September 10th following the outdoor service. Worship service begins at 10:00 AM
- Dates for the outdoor services are: June 11th and 25th, July 9th and 23rd, August 13th and 27th, September 3rd and 10th.
- The altar candles will be replaced by oil candles when the supply of wax candles is depleted.
- The idea of seasonal and welcoming banners was discussed. F. Brillhart made a motion to pursue the idea and D. Bankert seconded and all approved.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
